



Remote Learning Policy

The main aims of remote learning at Langley Moor Nursery school are to:

- Keep children curious, engaged with their world, busy, active and learning.
- Encourage regular contact with our children and families.
- To help parents understand the Early Years curriculum so that they can support their child's learning and development at home.

Absence of over 3 days	A seasonal activity sheet will be emailed or posted with home learning activities which will compliment activities taking place in nursery.
Absence of over 10 days	More learning activities will be emailed Parents/carers will be sign posted to appropriate websites eg Hungry Little Minds, and reminded about learning activities on our nursery website.
Closure of bubble or whole nursery due to positive case	Children will be provided with a home learning pack of ideas to take home.

Our leadership team will respond to emails from families with the aim of supporting and encouraging their home learning.

Vulnerable Families and Children

The headteacher and deputy headteacher who are also the two designated safeguarding leads will contact vulnerable pupils weekly when those children are not at school. Should they not be able to communicate with the vulnerable family, the social worker will be informed. Staff can access secure email from home.
